CRITERIA

Legal resident of Southern Oklahoma - Applicant's domicile (true, permanent home and the place they intend to return to after any temporary absences) must be in Carter, Garvin, Jefferson, Johnston, Love, Marshall, Murray, or Stephens Co.

High School Graduate - If applicant has never studied at a higher education institution before, they must be a high school graduate with at least a 2.5 GPA OR an ACT score of 19 or higher.

Good academic standing with all higher education institutions - If applicant has previously attended, or currently attends, other higher education institutions, they must demonstrate achieving and maintaining a cumulative (or grad/retention) 2.5 GPA or higher.

Have not previously completed a bachelor's degree

Enrolled in six (6) or more credit hours - Study to be conducted in person or online using the Ardmore Campus resources of Murray State College or Langston University, during the semester in which the application is made. Zero level classes do not count toward required hours.

Demonstration of financial need

Personal situation - Applicant must demonstrate that they are an "underprivileged but ambitious young person" who would be unable to pursue higher education without financial aid

VERIFICATION METHOD

One of the following:

- ☐ A valid Oklahoma driver's license, or
- ☐ a state ID card, or
- ☐ utility bill in the applicant's name

One of the following:

- ☐ HS Transcript, or
- ☐ Evidence of ACT score
- ☐ Provide a complete, comprehensive transcript that includes all prior college courses (it does not need to be official)

- ☐ By their signature on the application, the applicant affirms that they have not previously completed a bachelor's degree

- ☐ Copy of enrollment for the current semester, and
- ☐ Copy of most recent billing statement

- ☐ Student Aid Index (SAI) to verify that the applicant would be unable to pursue higher education without financial aid

- ☐ A 1-page personal statement
