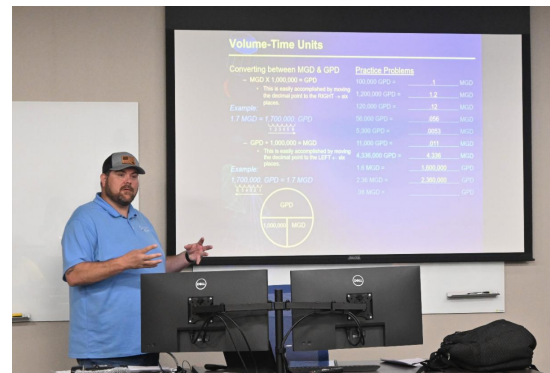
Catch up on what's happening at Murray State!
