## Andrews Wins Saddlebronc Championship



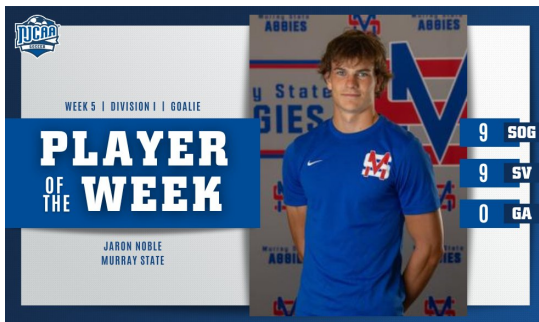
Cason Andrews won the Novice Saddlebronc Division Championship in the World Finals of the Professional Youth Roughstock Association!
