Bass Fishing Climbs in National Rankings



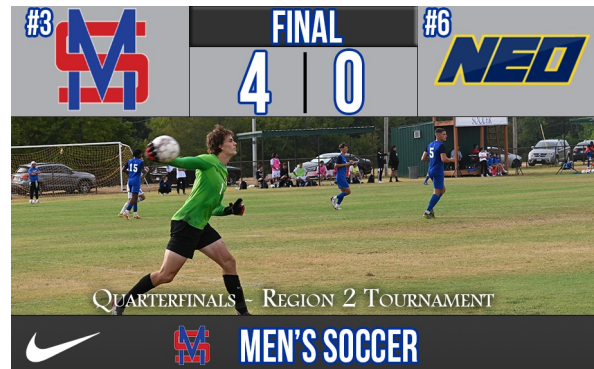
The Murray State Bass Fishing Team continues to climb in the national rankings.
