The A Team claimed the No. 2 seed for the Community College National Championship Tournament, while

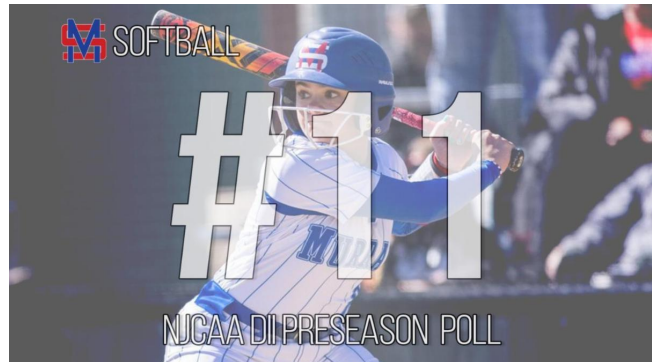
the Murray State B Team earned the No. 7 seed.



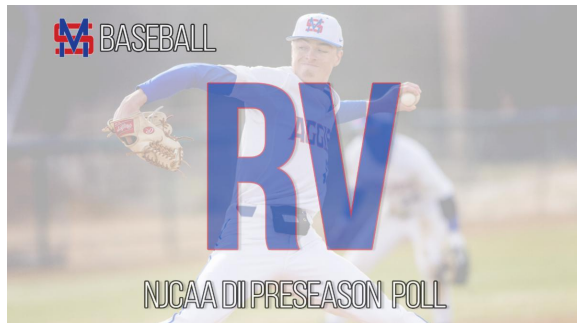
Softball No. 11 in Preseason Poll
