With this week's results, both Aggie teams are in third place in the Region 2

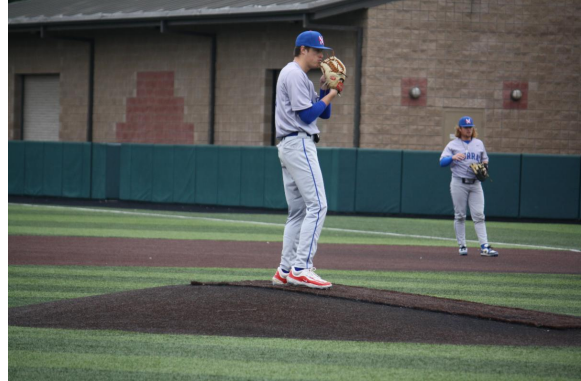
