Outcomes Information for the most recent two years (2021 & 2022) the following information is provided:

- Graduation rates for 2022 to 2023 are: 2022 – 84.6% and 2023 – 75%. This data reflects that reported to CAPTE and is based on the completion of students offered a position in the class.
- Over ninety percent (> 90%) of students who begin the full-time Fall Semester of the technical year of the PTA program during the most recent two years successfully completed the PTA program.
- Graduates during the 21/22 period have an 90.9% ultimate pass rate on the NPTE licensure examination. The Class of 23 has not completed testing.
- Graduates who sought employment report finding jobs within 3 months of graduation. The employment rate is calculated based on those graduates who were seeking employment and found employment (FT, PT, or contract) within 12 months of graduation. Graduates from these classes report high job satisfaction (> 90%) on graduate surveys.
- Supervising PTs and employers report graduates performing at appropriate entry-level and that they would hire a graduate from the MSC PTA program again. (>95%)

Employment rate includes those licensed graduates who sought employment and who found employment (FT, PT, Contract) as identified by the graduate survey and state licensure identification of workplace. The employment rate for one-year post-graduation will be posted once graduate survey data is received.
